Refugees Transfers - Procedure

Dear all,

Following the massive influx of refugees in some European countries and in order to facilitate their participation in our sport, the following procedure has been established with regard to International Transfers:

1. GENERAL

The following table determines whether an ITC is required or not:

2. WITHOUT ITC

For players not requiring an ITC, the following information shall still be collected and kept in a list by each federation for cross-checking with the VIS system:

- Name and Maiden name if applicable / First Name
- Date of Birth
- Country of Origin
- Official asylum registration document number (keep a copy)
- ID details if available (keep a copy)
- Each NF shall send the list with the names and receiving clubs to CEV

3. WITH ITC

For players requiring an ITC, the player will be under the FIVB umbrella for the 2015/2016 season only after a thorough check in VIS that the player does not already have a profile in the system.

Therefore all the player's details will have to be sent to FIVB – <u>transfer@fivb.org</u> for the player's profile to be created in the system. Once this has been done, the normal transfer procedure will apply.

The above should meet all the requirements to allow people to find some comfort and let them play volleyball!
