- Valid health certificate of each player (M-3 Form)
- Advertising authorisation for any markings on the team uniform and track suits
- Anti-doping education program diploma for each team representative
- A Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions Certificate demonstrating that all Team Delegation members have successfully completed the FIVB e-learning Course on the Prevention of the Competition Manipulation
- Medical Accreditation (from FIVB or CEV) of a medical doctor and/or physiotherapist

Accommodation

Teams: Max. 12 players + 4 officials per delegation ex. referee
Players: 4 triplerooms per team (2 beds and 1 mattress pr. room)
Staff: 2 doublerooms per team
Toilet and shower shared by 2 rooms.
Referees: TBA

NB! We are living in rooms where students normally live. You will be a guest in their domain, and we therefore kindly ask you to take care and treat their things with care.

Linnen

We kindly ask you to bring bedlinen (sengelinned) and towels, we provide bed, duvet (dyne) and pillow. If you don't bring bedlinen and towels, it can be rented for 150,- dkr per person. Inform Lotte Andersen before 1st of October, if you need to rent linen and towels.

Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served at ISI.

You will have the opportunity to register when you want to eat each day – depending on your match schedule. You can register mealtimes on a piece of paper hanging in the dining room.

At each meal, the coach/team manager is asked to announce the team's arrival in the kitchen. It will be a great help for the kitchen, so they can be sure that all teams get food.

Please let us know in advance if you have any special dietary requirements, e.g. vegetarians, allergies etc.

Laundry

You will receive a washing card to be used for the machines. You do it yourselves. Please ask for guiding if you have questions. There are machines next to room 59 and below the dining room.

Transportation between accommodation and competition site

Financial matters

Each participating team will cover

- Travel all the way to Ikast and back home again
- Payment of all costs regarding their own referees

- Per diem for food and lodging is 75,- euros per day per person - € 300,- per person.

Playing system

6 Teams: If there are 6 teams participating, there will be 2 groups. Each group will play a round-robin.

- The 1st ranked team in each group will play semi-final.
- The 2nd and 3rd ranked team in each group will play quarterfinal against the team from the other group.
- The winner of the quarterfinals will play semi-finals.
- The loser of the quarterfinals will play 5th/6th place.
- The winner of the semi-finals will play 1st/2nd place.
- The losers of the semi-finals will play 3rd/4th place.
- The matches will be played during 3 days and in two halls/courts if there are both boys and girls, or two group ages, playing championships at the same time and site.

Rules

FIVB rules are valid for the tournament.

Four persons are allowed to sit on the bench (all four have to be on the NEVZA-5bis).

Team composition

A team can consist of maximum 12 players (12+0 libero, 11+1 libero or 10+2 liberos). Less than 12 players are accepted. The libero can be changed to other players in between matches during the tournament. A change of libero should be announced to the secretary and referees at the latest 60 minutes before the start of the match or as soon as possible according to the finish time of the previous match.

Playing Protocol

Official warm up	32 minutes before start
Toss	18 minutes to start
Warm up 2 x 5 min. At net + serve	17 minutes to start
Warm up stops – Line up – presenting the captains and the HC	5 minutes to start
National anthems	4 minutes to start
Procedure for handing over pins will be informed	
Starting players sitting on the bench	
Presentation referees	2 minutes to start
Presentation starting 7 players	1 minutes to start

If the match before is delayed, the warmup Hall B is available. You will have, all together, 32 minutes on the match court before the match starts.

Point system

The point system will be according to the CEV rules.

1. Matches won
2. Ranking Points (3-0 or 3-1: 3 points, 3-2: 2 points, 2-3: 1 point, 0-3 or 1-3: 0 point)
3. Set Quotient
4. Match Point Quotient
5. If the tie continues, as per their match point quotient, the teams will be placed according to the result(s) of the match(es) between the teams concerned.

Streaming

Sportway will make livestreaming for all matches. More information will be distributed later.

Dream Team nomination

Nomination for Dream Team is to be handed over to Henrik Petersen before the start of the final in each gender. Ballots will be distributed at the latest on Tuesday.

Others

Official team photo will be taken, at the team's first match.

Price ceremony in Hall A after the last final. All teams must be present, wearing uniforms or warmup suits.
