Section 3. Time Tables

Preliminary inquiry: Upon arrival, at ISI

Each delegation must bring the following to the Preliminary Inquiry:

- Passport or other photo-ID for identity
- Final Team Registration (Registration of the 12 players). NEVZA CH-05bis form has to be completed before the Preliminary Inquiry and handed over to the Tournament Director during the Preliminary Inquiry
- Sample of each colour of uniforms of captain and libero (minimum 2 colours are needed)
- Receipt of financial matters paid to Volleyball Denmark

Competition and Training schedule

Training times will be confirmed after receiving arrival times of the teams. We will make sure that all teams have at least one hour of training on a competition court before the matches start.

Section 4. Practical information

Accommodation

Teams: Max.12 players + 4 officials per delegation ex. referee
Players: 4 triplerooms per team (2 beds and 1 mattress pr. room)
Staff: 2 doublerooms per team
Toilet and shower shared by 2 rooms.
Referees: TBA

NB! We are living in rooms where students normally live. You will be a guest in their domain, and we therefore kindly ask you to take care and treat their things with care.

Linnen

We kindly ask you to bring bedlinen (sengelinned) and towels, we provide bed, duvet (dyne) and pillow. If you don't bring bedlinen and towels, it can be rented for 150,- dkr per person. Inform Lotte Andersen before 1st of October, if you need to rent linen and towels.

Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served at ISI.
Meal times will be determined according to the match and training schedule.
Please let us know in advance if you have any special dietary requirements, e.g. vegetarians, allergies etc.

Transportation between accommodation and competition site

Distance from ISI (accommodation) to Ikast Sports Center is 400 m. So we will walk forth and back.

Transportation between airport and venue

We can upon request and payment organize bus transportation from the airport to the venue. Please contact Mie Andersen at mie@volleyball.dk, at the latest the 15th of September.

Registration

Each participating team can register a delegation composed of maximum 12 players and 4 officials + 1 referee per team.

The visiting teams are obliged to send the **NEVZA CH-05 form** to the organizers at the latest 30 days before the competition by e-mail. The number of players on this list is unlimited.

NB! Volleyball Denmark would like to have the exact arrival and departure times of the visiting teams and information about the size of delegation, including the number of men/women in the staff and number of referees, as soon as possible. Please use the attached **Entry Form**. Send to: mie@volleyball.dk latest the 15th of August.

It is of very big importance, that you register the right number of people in your delegation before the end of the deadline. Also let us know the gender of the leaders and referees. Please notice, that if you don't do that, you will be fined according to the regulations.

Financial matters

Each participating team will cover

- Travel all the way to Ikast and back home again
- Payment of all costs regarding their own referees
- Per diem for food and lodging is 75,- euros per day per person - € 300,- per person.

Rules

FIVB rules are valid for the tournament.

Libero

A team can consist of maximum 12 players (12+0 libero, 11+1 libero or 10+2 liberos). Less than 12 players are accepted. The libero can be changed to other players in between matches during the tournament. A change of libero should be announced to the secretary and referees at the latest 60 minutes before the start of the match or as soon as possible according to the finish time of the previous match.

Playing Protocol

Official warm up	32 minutes before start
Toss	18 minutes to start
Warm up 2 x 5 min. At net + serve	17 minutes to start
Warm up stops – Line up – presenting the captains and the HC	5 minutes to start
National anthems	4 minutes to start
Procedure for handing over pins will be informed	
Starting players sitting on the bench	
Presentation referees	2 minutes to start
Presentation starting 7 players	1 minutes to start

If the match before is delayed, you will have, all together, 32 minutes before the start of the next match.

Referees

Each federation must bring a referee for each team (boys and girls = 2 referees). Please notice that the fine for not bringing the correct number of referees will be 750,- euros for each missing referee, according to the regulations.

Pointsystem

The pointsystem will be according to the CEV rules.

1. Matches won

2. Ranking Points (3-0 or 3-1: 3 points, 3-2: 2 points, 2-3: 1 point, 0-3 or 1-3: 0 point)
3. Set Quotient
4. Match Point Quotient
5. If the tie continues, as per their match point quotient, the teams will be placed according to the result(s) of the match(es) between the teams concerned.
